As a Rider...

Be visible have headlight on at all times when traveling.

Be aware of vehicle blind spots both auto and truck. Stay out of them when possible.

Drive defensively: paying attention to other drivers, leaving a space cushion and yourself a way out of a possible accident.

People driving cars often just don't see motorcycles. Even when drivers do see you, chances are they've never been on a motorcycle and can't properly judge your speed.

As a driver of an auto or truck we have a responsibility as well.

Pay close attention at intersections look for a motorcycle.

With the smaller size when compared to an auto you may not realize the speed at which the motorcycle is approaching. Treat it as it is closer than it looks.

When a motorcycle is stopping at an intersection you may not see a brake light because it is downshifting to slow down. Pay close attention to your space cushion. 3 to 4 seconds.

When a motorcycle is in motion don't think of it as a vehicle but as a person.

By remembering some these few tips we will able to be safer both when riding a motorcycle as well as when driving around one.
