- 3. **Proposed Rule: Hours of Service of Drivers** FMCSA proposes to revise the regulations for hours of service for drivers of property-carrying commercial motor vehicles. A copy of the Rule Comparison Chart was available on each table.
- 4. **Proposed Rule: Restricting the Use of Cellular Phones** the FMCSA proposes to restrict the use of hand-held mobile telephones, including hand-held cell phones, by drivers of CMVs while operating in interstate commerce.

 - Request record search for all new drivers prior to allowing them to operate a commercial vehicle for your company

 - Since January 2008, 946 companies registered for the online system
